SWIMMING AND SAFETY

Please remember that you are ultimately responsible for the safety of your family and your guests. There is no substitute for your ACTIVE SUPERVISION!

Swimmers who are dependent on floatation devices to swim must be accompanied by a guardian who is in the water within one arms reach, **ACTIVELY WATCHING THEM.**

According to the Pelican Lakes Management members may use the pool unaccompanied by a guardian **IF** they are at least 10 years old **AND** can pass a swim test conducted by the staff.

Please be aware that the lifeguard staff has the authority to **close the pool at any time; therefore your swimmers may be sent home unexpectedly.**



SWIMMING LESSONS

According to the CDC children ages 1-4 who participate in formal swimming lessons are 88% less likely to drown. Let us help your children learn to be safe and strong swimmers! Registration for the Splash Water Wise Swimming Lessons Program is held at the pool **and/or online** after May 25th. Group Lesson Session Dates:

- Session 1 June 5-June 16
- Session 2 June 19- June 30
- Session 3 July 10-July 21
- Session 4 July 24-August 4

The second Friday of each session is reserved for make-up classes in the event of a full class cancellation.

Classes run between 9:00am and 11:00am each session. Specific class times are set prior to each session.

Please consult the registration notebook or speak with the pool manager to determine the correct placement for your swimmer.

Private and semi-private lessons are available at your convenience. Please speak with the pool manager to make arrangements.

The cost for group lessons follows:

Parent Tot \$35 for pool members
\$50 for non-members

Parent Tot runs Monday/Wednesday/Friday, Monday/Wednesday. These classes run for 25 minutes.

Levels 1-6 and Specialty Classes

\$50 for members (\$30 for ½ session).
\$65 for non-members (\$45 for ½ session).

Levels 1-4 run for 25 minutes.

Levels 5-6 and Specialty Classes run for 40 minutes.

POOL ACCESS REQUIREMENTS

Please register for pool membership at the Pro Shop. All pool members must be listed on the registration form originally given out when registering for a membership. All members must have their photo taken and stored in the membership database in order to access the pool. *Returning pool members do not need to have their photos retaken.* New members will have their photo taken the first time they use the pool.

Please contact Stacy at the Pro Shop if you have not received the registration form.

Members should check in AND out at the lifeguard shack located at the west entrance of the pool.

Wristbands will be required of everyone using the beach. See the lifeguards at the shack for a band.

GUEST POLICY

Your friends and family are welcome to enjoy the pool with you!

Golf and social memberships come with 2 free seasonal guest passes. Each pass is good for 1 swimmer each day throughout the season. Additional guests are welcome for \$3. Punch cards may also be purchased in packs of 12 for \$30.

Members must check their guests in upon arrival. Each guest will be given a wristband to wear during their visit.

A pool member must always accompany guests to the pool.

Please remember that you are ultimately responsible for the safety of your family and your guests. Make sure you are confident in the swimming abilities of your children's guests prior to sending them down to the pool without you.

BE AWARE!

For every child less than 15 years old who dies from drowning in a pool, another 10 receive emergency department care for nonfatal submersion injuries. Nonfatal drowning can cause brain damage that may result in long-term disabilities including memory problems, learning disabilities, and permanent physical impairment.

Mackenzie's Mission is a local nonprofit organization that provides water safety and life jacket education. The goal of this program is to supply individuals and families with the necessary knowledge to prevent water tragedies around open water, and around the home, in order to reduce fatal drowning and non-fatal drowning incidents in Colorado. The organization was founded in 2011 by Trista Roecker and her daughter Heather Roecker. In 2005, Trista's daughter, Mackenzie, suffered a non-fatal drowning that resulted in significant brain damage. This experience has driven Trista and Heather to provide water safety and life jacket education to encourage the prevention of water related brain injuries and deaths.

Mackenzie's Mission is a qualified 501(c)(3) organization that operates entirely on a volunteer basis. A very small percentage, about 1.5%, of our funding goes toward non program related costs. Mackenzie's Mission currently provides a water safety and life jacket education program and is actively working to create both a life jacket exchange program and a life jacket loaner board program at local pools and lakes within Larimer County.
